#### ABOUT OUR EVANGELISTS:

**Dr. Nina G. Gunter** is a retired general superintendent in the Church of the Nazarene and was the first woman to be honored with the highest office in the church. She has also served as the General Director of Nazarene Missions International. Dr. Gunter was called to preach at the age of 12 years. Upon answering her call to ministry at age 14, her pastor asked her to speak in the next church service. Thus began her many years of ministry. Dr. Gunter earned a bachelor's degree from Trevecca Nazarene University (TNU) and a master's degree from the University of South Carolina in Columbia. She has served congregations as co-pastor with her husband in Tennessee, Missouri, and South Carolina. Dr. Gunter was honored by her alma mater, TNU, with the honorary doctor of divinity degree, the first woman to receive such recognition from the university. She was elected Ministerial Alumnus of the Year in 1990 by TNU alumni. In 2005 she was also named the T. W. Willingham "Preacher of the Year" by Nazarene Bible College. In 2006 Olivet Nazarene University accorded her the Maggie Sloan Crawford Award for her visionary leadership and example. Dr. Gunter is a preacher, teacher, and author, having written *The Traveler's Psalm*, *Our Defining Moment*, *Christian Perfection*, *The Cross—Seize It! Share It!*, and *Holy Leadership in a Hectic World*.

**Dan Bohi** is a lay evangelist on whom a very special call to ministry has come to his life. Dan was raised in Olathe, Kansas, surrounded by strong-hearted believers who nurtured within his mind and heart, a love for God and the Church. Born to longtime Nazarene Evangelist, Jim and Carolyn Bohi, Dan's father was often away from home, singing the Gospel message in churches literally around the world. In 1995 Dan was severely injured in a collision with a heavy construction truck. Months spent in a hospital bed presented Dan with few options. The one that he exercised was to read the Word of God hour after hour. That Word came alive to Dan and he experienced a personal encounter with Jesus that was truly life changing! As the healing process ensued, something else was changing. No longer satisfied with a nominal relationship with Christ, Dan experienced an ever-deepening immersion into the very life of Christ. Stepping away from familiar routines and laying down the tools of a craftsman, Dan Bohi ventured out by faith in response to God's new vision of evangelism as he has ministered in prisons, retreats, camp meetings, conferences as well as local churches. A new blueprint preoccupies Dan's mind and heart — the Word of God — from God, to the people of God for times like these. As a speaker, Dan is unlike most. He reads the Bible through every 30 days and is able to quote much of it. He weaves the Scriptures together in a pattern that brings life changing news to people seeking more from life. With an open Bible and a warm heart, Dan preaches God's message to both the Church and the world ... a message of Hope, Holiness and Power!
