ADDITIONAL INFO:At our coaches meeting on Saturday, I introduced some questions to the Northern area to aid me in making decisions for the district quiz program. Some of these I had spoken with Ruth Ann about, so the Southern area wasn't left out. **REPORT ON HOW CHANGES WENT!**

#1 It had been suggested to me that I should **consider lowering the registration fees**, thus lowering awards due to the status of our economy. **After discussion, it was decided to leave our registration fees and current awards as is. The vote was almost unanimous.** RuthAnn indicated that the south would agree with this decision. **MAINTAINED THIS DECISION AT THE 2ND INVITATIONAL**

#2 **Invitational Questions.** Kansas City has a retired director who always wrote questions for the invitationals. She has volunteered to continue to do that for CBQ working thru Headquarters to get to all the district directors for use. Jenni Montebalco has coordinated this with her and I actually received these questions for this quiz. I chose NOT to use them because I wanted you all to know about this first. I would welcome the opportunity to use these questions that are Kansas City approved. My concern with this invitational was that I could not guarantee that the breakdown would be as I stated in my Aug 2009 letter as to what you could expect as far as questions, i.e. so many straight out of the student/leaders books, so many reworded from student/leaders books, and each round to have one memory based question, but NOT memory work. I can only guarantee that my team will continue to 'scrub' the questions for accuracy, to avoid any possibility of challenges. The coaches were again almost, if not unanimous, in their agreement to use these questions. They, like myself, liked the idea that all invitationals questions across the country would be the same, as they now currently are for Zones, Districts and most recently Regionals. ***So with that, Central Ohio will be using these questions, we will not be writing our own anymore. YIPPEE! SEEMED TO WORK GREAT AT THE NORTHERN QUIZ...NO COMPLAINTS!!***

This did bring up another question though: Since we are so trying to following Kansas City guidelines, it was recommended that we should then consider going back to the standard '15 questions per round for Red Level and 20 questions per round for Blue Level' even for these invitationals. If you remember, a few years ago, we had decided to reduce down from 3 rounds to 2 rounds and just increase each round by five questions to try give the quizzers more of an opportunity to answer questions, but eliminate so much downtime with the breaks between questions. I guess it may have benefited the quizzers, but it sure made the scorekeeping complicated with the perfect round ribbons. After discussion, it was again almost unanimous for us to go back to the 15 questions round for Red Level and the 20 questions round for Blue Level. We will, however, still only do TWO rounds of questions!.....This should help shorten the length of our quiz events! This is effective immediately.....Our Feb Quiz will only have a total of 30 questions for Red Level and 40 questions for Blue level (two rounds each). **THIS REALLY SHORTENED THE DAY!!**

#3 **Memory Work/ Certificates**

The Northern Area began sometime ago giving the children an opportunity to recite memory work at our quizzes. We usually did this during tallykeeping time/ coaches meeting time to help fill a void. The quizzers were then recognized with a certificate acknowledging their memory work accomplishments. After discussion, it was decided that we would do this at two events each year, preferably the 2nd Invitational, because by then they have been exposed to all memory work, and then again at Districts. So for the 2010-2011 quiz year, we will only do the 2nd Invitational and District Finals. **TO SPEED THINGS UP, WE WILL HAVE STATIONS W/BALLOONS SO QUIZZERS CAN RECITE THEIR VERSES THROUGHOUT THE DAY EVEN BEFORE & DURING RED AND BLUE LEVEL QUIZZING!**

#4 **Music/Entertainment/Object Lesson** during the Coaches Meeting and downtime for Tallykeeping I have asked the hosting churches to please consider music/entertainment during the above to help keep our children occupied. My only concern in doing this is that a church will feel that they cannot 'HOST' a quiz

because of this request. Please do not let that stop you. I just need for you to let me know so that I can request help from others.

Central Ohio Quizzer of the Year

The Biby Park Memorial "Quizzer of the Year" Award is presented to the Children's Bible Quizzer selected from nominations submitted by each church who has a CBQ program. This is an annual award (plaque/trophy) presented to the nominee elected at the District Quiz Finals. Also there is a traveling plaque with the quizzers name and church on it, that is to be displayed in each church for the duration of the quiz year.

NOMINATION GUIDELINES:

1. Only one quizzer nominated from each church
2. Consider scores at practices and how well the quizzer retains God's Word (don't use this as the only guideline; (e.g., the top scorer may fall short in other areas).
3. Consider attendance at quiz practices.
4. Consider behavior at practices and quiz competitions.
5. Consider the quizzers Sunday School and Church attendance record.
6. Consider the quizzer's overall Christian Character.
7. School & outside activities that reflect a Christ-like Spirit may also be used.

Your nomination should be the one quizzer that stands out above others in their attitude, behavior and knowledge of the Scriptures you are studying.

A complete resume of each coach's nomination is required to be mailed to the District Director at least one month PRIOR to the District Quiz Finals, in order to allow time for a panel of judges to make a selection and get the awards engraved.
